


Theory Worksheet

In music we use 7 letters for the notes: A B C D E F G. After G you go back to A:
A B C D E F G A B C D E F G

The four open strings: G, D, A, E. Note that G is the lowest and E is the highest


Violin





When you put your second finger on the tape, you go up one note from your first finger


